

ORDINANCE NO. 69-A

AN ORDINANCE OF THE BOROUGH OF HOWARD, CENTRE COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 69 PROHIBITING "BURNING" DURING CERTAIN HOURS AND PROVIDING FINES FOR VIOLATION OF SAID ORDINANCE AND RE-ENACTING THE REMAINING PROVISIONS OF ORDINANCE NO. 69.

BE IT ENACTED AND ORDAINED by the Borough of Howard and it is hereby enacted and ordained by authority of the same as follows:

SECTION ONE:

Section Four of Ordinance No. 69 shall be amended to contain the following additional language:

No burning as described in this Section Four shall be permitted between the hours of 7:00 p.m. until 7:00 a.m. inclusive.

SECTION TWO:

Section Thirteen shall be amended to read as follows: Any person, firm or corporation violating any of the provisions of this ordinance shall upon conviction thereof in a summary proceeding before a district magistrate or any other proper authority shall be subject to a fine of not less than \$100.00 nor more than \$300.00 for each offense and in default of said fine and costs of prosecution shall be committed to the county jail for a period not to exceed 30 days. Each day that the violation of this ordinance is continued shall constitute a separate offense and separate proceedings may be instituted and separate penalties imposed for each such days' offense after the first conviction.

SECTION THREE :

All other provisions of Ordinance No. 69 are hereby ratified and re-enacted,

SECTION FOUR:

The within ordinance shall be effective August 1, 1983.
